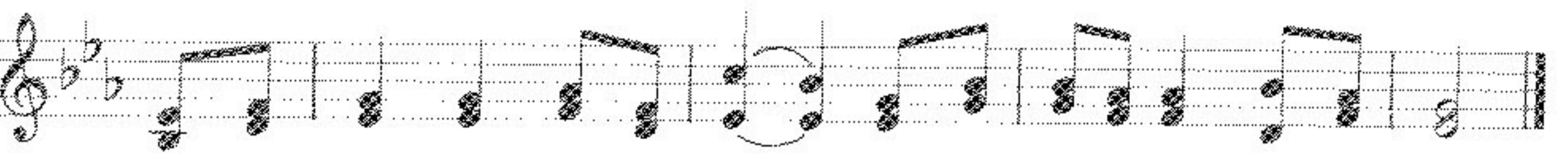
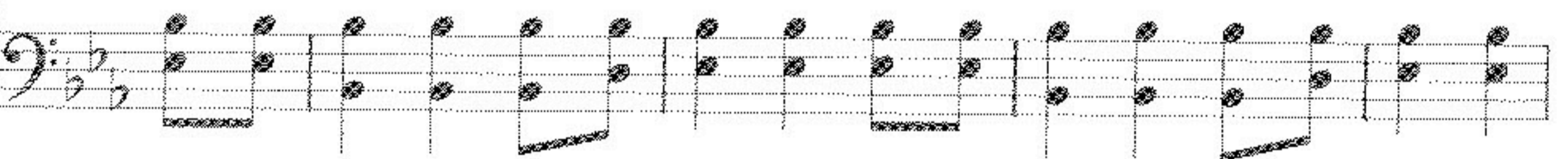
1. Can you count the stars that bright-ly Twin-kle in the mid-night sky?
